Sending – how can I pass on items to other Users?

You can forward a list of search results or a news item/ a picture or a graphic by using the *Forward* button in the results list or by pressing *As E-Mail* in the detailed view of a particular document.

Before you select a list of search results or a detailed view of a document from the search list you must choose the item by entering a tick in the appropriate box alongside. You can then decide whether to send the entire results list as an E-Mail or the detailed view of the story as an E-Mail by clicking *Full Text as E-Mail*.



Alternatively you can call up the detailed view of a news item/ an image/ a graphic first and send it from there using the As E-Mail button.
